- Put garbage out to the directed place by 8:30 a.m.
- Everyone who is responsible for the place should keep it clean.

Trimmed Tree Branches	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Trimmed Tree Branches * Must be less than 10cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Throw them away as combustible garbage.
